- Jeri Castillo, widowed single mother of five, whose children were removed after the serious physical abuse of her six-year-old--also in August 2012. Her children removed by CPS included a set of infant twins.
- Benita Trevino who was incarcerated for theft last July after she admitted stealing to help support a drug habit that kept her from caring for her child.

What: A special **CPS** and Children's Court docket dismissing the cases of the parents and reunifying them with their children. Their reunifications come after extensive work with **CPS**.
